- 1. ENTRY FEE:** Entry into these awards is free.
- 2. CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:** The annual 'Artworks'! Art Awards 2010 are open to any adult resident of Queensland who has a proven disability. Entrants must have proof of eligibility such as a DSP or a Treating Doctors Report. Entrants must be 18 - 64 years old to enter the awards.
- 3. HOW TO ENTER:** Entry forms can be downloaded from our website. Go to www.kithandkin.com.au. Then, in the links column, click on *downloads* to access entry forms.
 - MAIL an Entry form, A5 photo* of your artwork and a normal size photo of yourself with a short personal profile to: 'ArtWorks'! Kith and Kin Association Limited P.O. Box 6 Wulguru, QLD 4811
 - Entry forms must be received by 4pm, Friday 23rd July 2010. No late entries will be accepted.
 - First selection process will be judged on Wednesday 4th August 2010.
 - Notification of all entries selected for final judging will be sent on 5th and 6th August 2010. Artists will be asked to send selected works.

*Please note it is important to submit the photograph of your artwork with your entry form, as a Selection Panel of Judges will judge this initial entry.

Photos of Artists and Profile will be submitted into catalogue along with photo of artwork.

- 4. ENTRY CRITERIA:** Artists may enter 4 works in total with a maximum of 2 works in any one section.

Details of Sections and Prizes:

Xstrata Award - overall winner - \$500

Photography - any subject 1st 2nd and 3rd prizes TBA

Assisted - any subject, any medium 1st 2nd and 3rd prizes TBA

Unassisted - any subject, any medium 1st 2nd and 3rd prizes TBA

ArtWorks! Encouragement award - Encouragement prize TBA

5. SIZE AND FRAMING:

- All works must be wired and fitted with "D" rings ready for hanging.
- Canvases must not exceed 1m x 1m unframed.
- Photographs should be A4 size

Any artwork not correctly presented may be refused.

- 6. IDENTIFICATION:** All selected entries must have label attached to back of work displaying Artist's name, Section, Title of Work, Medium used and Sale Price if applicable.

- 7. STANDARDS:** The Awards Committee relies on the integrity of all competitors. Entries must be the artist's original work, executed during the past year and not previously entered in any other awards. Reproductions/Copies of other Artists work are not acceptable.

- 8. CATALOGUE:** Information will be taken from entry forms and no changes will be made. You must have a title for your entry at time of lodgement. We request that you keep your titles to a maximum of five words.

- 9. DELIVERING OF ART WORKS:** Works selected for finals must be received at Kith and Kin, 711 Flinders St., Townsville by 4pm Friday 20th August 2010, for categorising before hanging.

- 10. JUDGING:** Judging will be conducted by a prominent artist specialising in each section's medium. Final judging will be on Friday 10th September 2010. The judge's decision will be final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into. All awards will be allocated at the judge's discretion (eg. There may be insufficient entries).
- 11. AWARDS:** Prizes will be announced closer to the exhibition date
- 12. EXHIBITION OF WORKS:** An Exhibition of works selected for final judging will be held from the 12th - 22nd September 2010 at Umbrella Studio of Contemporary Art, Townsville. Works not selected into finals will be electronically displayed during the exhibition.
- 13. PRESENTATION CEREMONY:** Presentations will be awarded at the Opening Launch of the Exhibition on Monday 13th September 2010 starting at 10am at Umbrella Studios. All entrants, families and friends are welcome to attend. Light refreshments will be available.
- 14. SALE OF ARTWORK:** Work for sale is at the discretion of the Artist. All monies from sale of work will go to the Artist.
- 15. COSTS:** All freight costs and insurance of entries, forward to Kith and Kin Association Limited, will be borne by the competitor. Packing must be of a quality to allow for its reuse for return of unsold work. Kith and Kin agree to cover the costs of return freight, for out of town competitors, at completion of the exhibition. Kith and Kin take no responsibility for the safety of Artist's work and it is exhibited at their own risk. **Handy Hint:** Avoid submitting fragile works or works framed under glass. Use Perspex or other less fragile materials where possible.
- 16. COLLECTION OF ENTRIES:** Local competitors can collect their works from Kith and Kin Association Limited, 711 Flinders St, TOWNSVILLE during office hours, after Monday 11th October 2010. Out of town competitors should allow a delivery period of approximately 21 days thereafter for receipt of their freighted works and any prizes owing.
